

Make your own Little Pig Nose

Crafting your own pig nose can be a lot of fun! Here's a step-by-step guide to making your snout:

Materials you'll need:

5. Wear your new nose with pride: Your pig nose will be ready to wear! Hold the popsicle stick between your fingers and position the nose over your own nose. Now you're ready to oink and snort your way through some fun pretend play!
